What does it mean?

Isocrates says that an educated person does not simply know a lot. They can also judge everyday situations well and act appropriately. Today's thought clearly paraphrases this idea.

In daily life, we rarely know every fact. A simple process helps: write down the facts you know, name the open questions and check the possible results. This turns knowledge into a well-founded decision.

- 02 Note the facts you know and one question that is still open.
- 03 Consider which possible result matters most to you.
